

The Scholarship Programmes

The Scholarship Programmes offer many opportunities for cooperation with institutions in Norway, Iceland and Liechtenstein.

The aim of the Scholarship Programmes is to facilitate networking and knowledge exchange between educational institutions in Norway, Iceland and Liechtenstein and beneficiary states in Europe.

Partners can collaborate through institutional cooperation and mobility of students and staff in different programme

areas. Mobility between the countries is easier than in many other educational programmes because of the wide range of funding opportunities.

Working with joint challenges in education and research is of great value for institutions in the beneficiary and donor states.

The EEA Grants/Norway Grants aim to reduce social and economic disparities in Europe, and strengthen bilateral relations between donor and beneficiary states.

Who may apply?

Project support is available to institutions in 11 European countries: Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, Romania, the Slovak Republic, Slovenia and Spain. A partner in one of the donor states (Norway, Iceland or Liechtenstein) is required.

Activities

The beneficiary states have different programmes. Applicants can apply for activities such as:

- Institutional cooperation projects
- Individual mobility for students and staff
- Opportunities for PhD and Master's candidates in research projects

Applications

Institutions can apply for support from the summer of 2012. Projects must be completed by 2016. The Programme Operator in each beneficiary state manages the applications.

SIU's role

Norwegian Centre for International Cooperation in Education (SIU) is the focal point for the Scholarship Programmes in Norway. As a strategic adviser, SIU provides information and guidance to institutions and stakeholders in Norway and the beneficiary states.

EEA Grants/Norway Grants

- The EEA Grants/Norway Grants were established when the EU was extended by ten new members in 2004
- Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway are partners in the Scholarship Programmes. The Donor Programme Partners are SIU, Liechtenstein National Agency for International Education Affairs (www.aiba.llv.li) and The Icelandic Centre for Research (www.rannis.is/english/)
- The funds are transferred through two agreements: a scheme with Norway, Iceland and Liechtenstein (EEA Grants), and a Norwegian scheme (Norway Grants)
- Norway contributes 1.8 billion EUR to the EEA Grants/Norway Grants between 2009 and 2014
